

Viga Restoration Workshop

April 11-15, 2011 and August 1-5, 2011



Join Cornerstones Community Partnerships and the National Park Service in two viga-restoration workshops using the “screw-on end” technique. The focus of the work is the vigas at the National Landmark Old Santa Fe Trail Building, headquarters for the Intermountain Region National Park Service in Santa Fe, NM.

Workshop training will include:

- Lecture and discussion about vigas
- Survey and assessment of existing viga ends
- Preparation of new ends including casting procedures using epoxy
- preparation of old vigas for new ends
- final assembly and finishing

This will be excellent opportunity to learn about preservation treatments in compliance with the Secretary of the Interior’s Standards for Rehabilitation.
